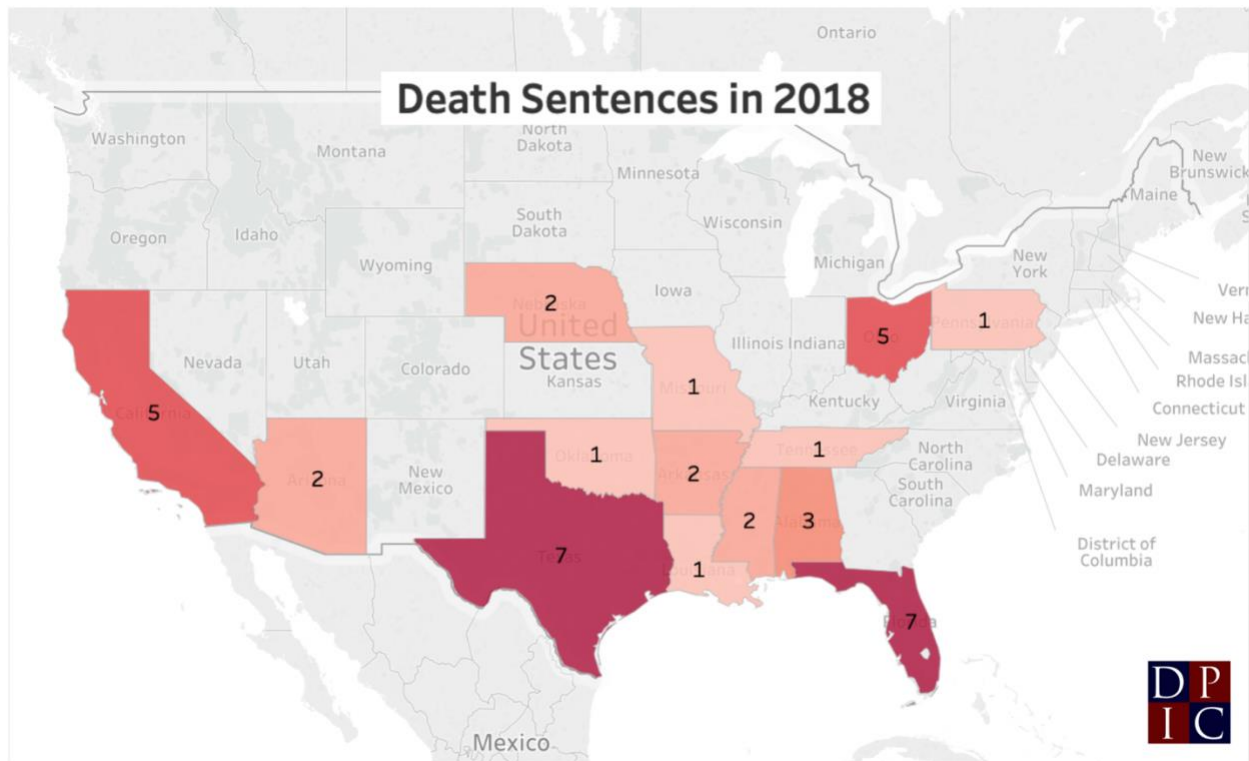

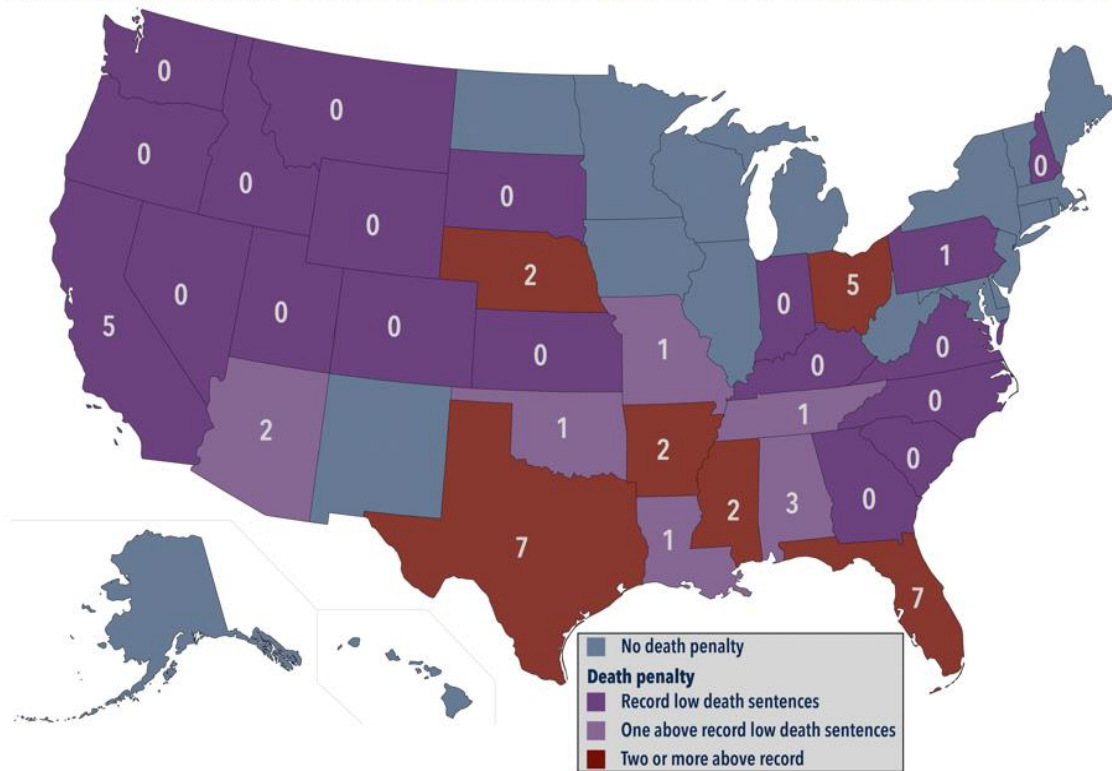

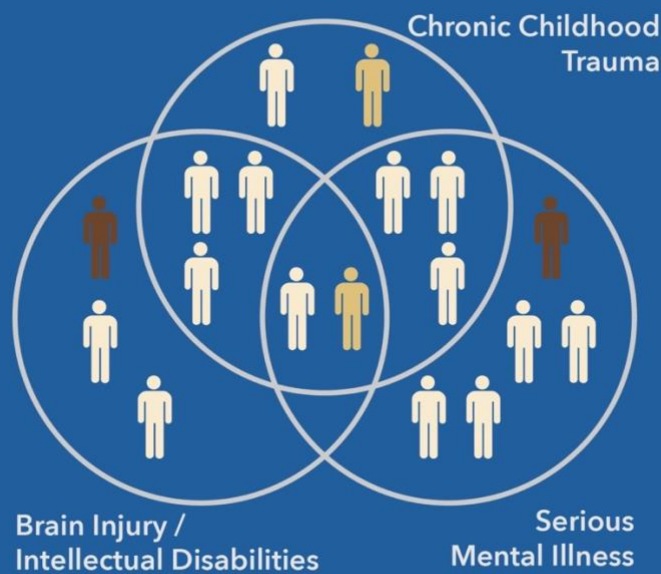

Prisoners Executed in 2018



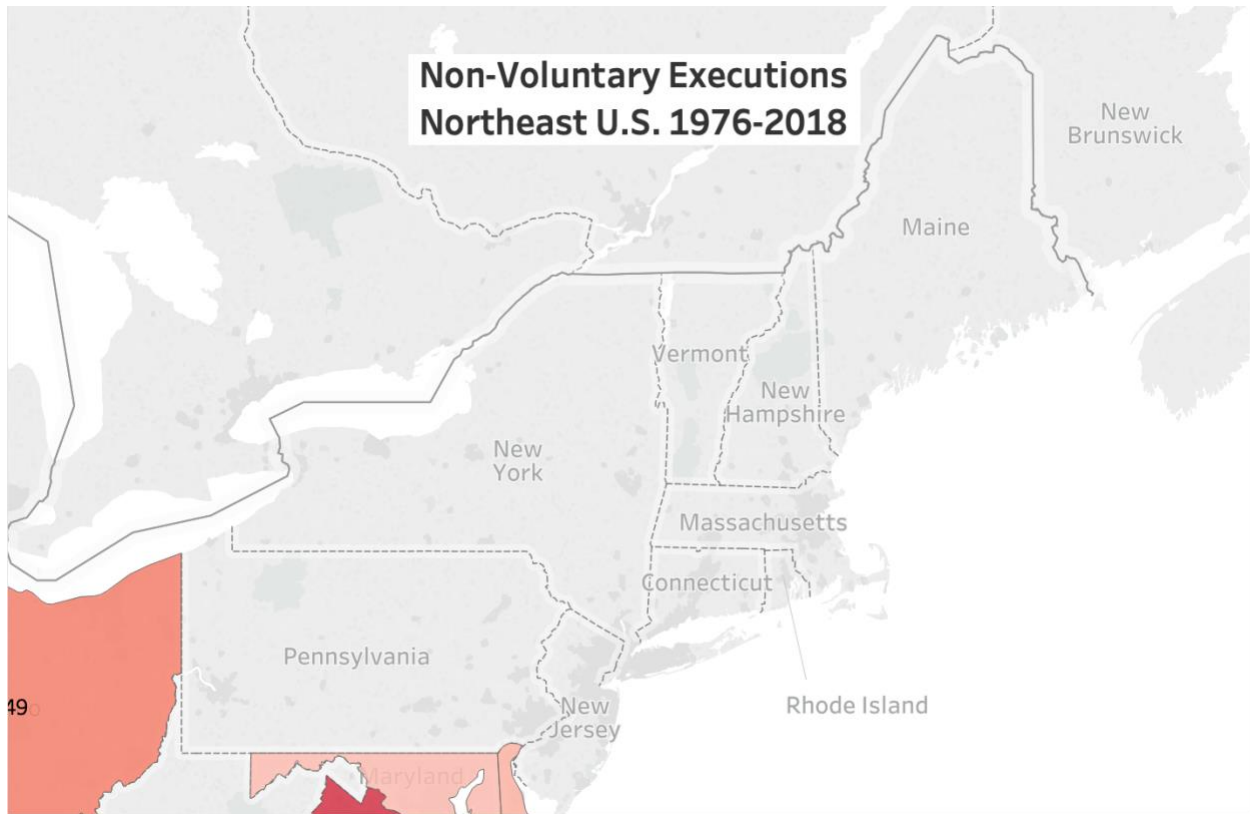
At least 18 of the 25 people executed in 2018 had significant mental, emotional, or cognitive impairments.

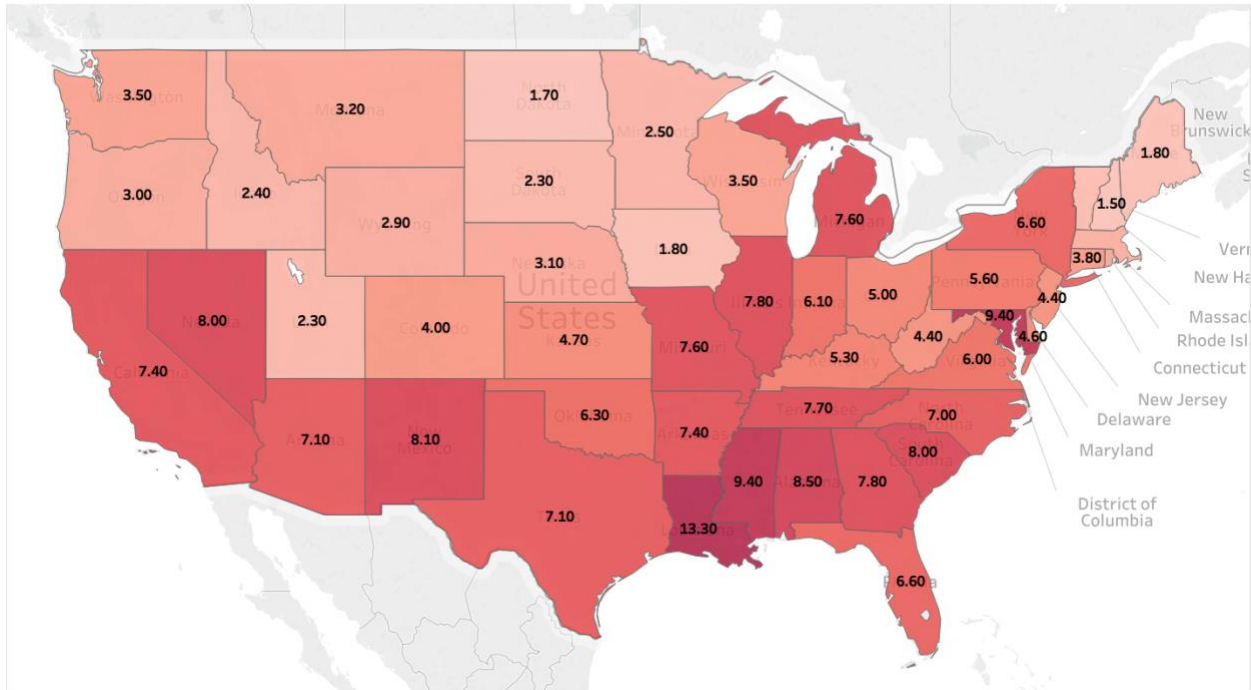

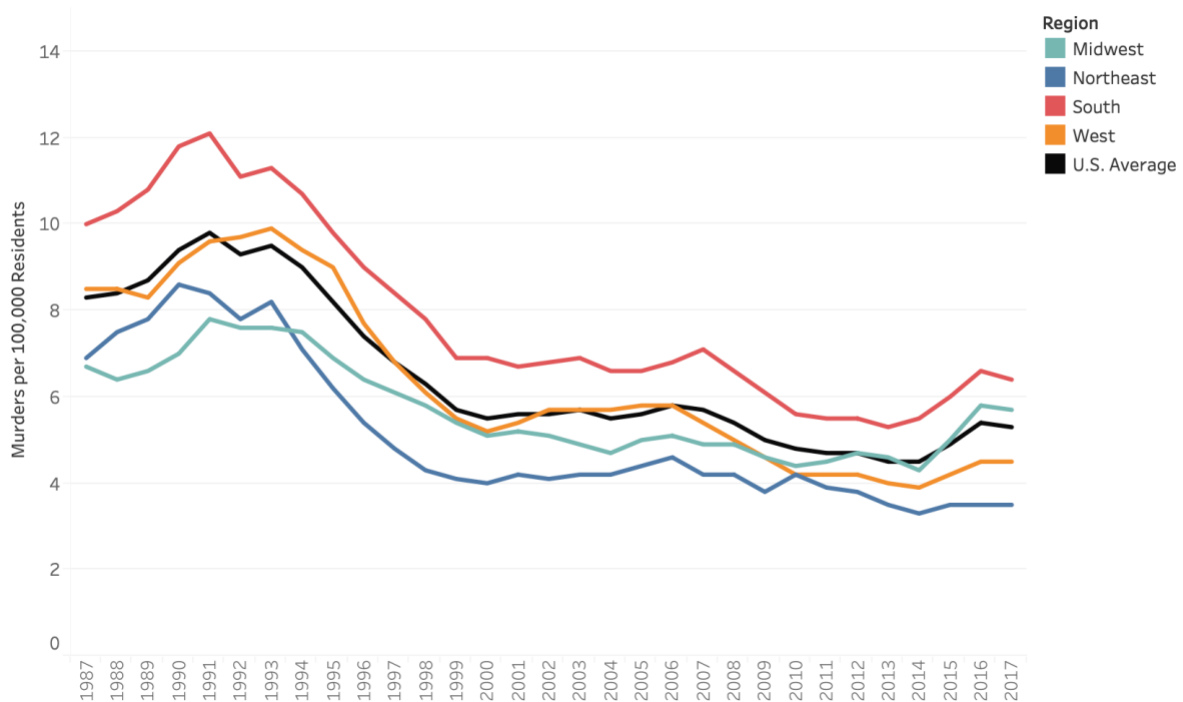

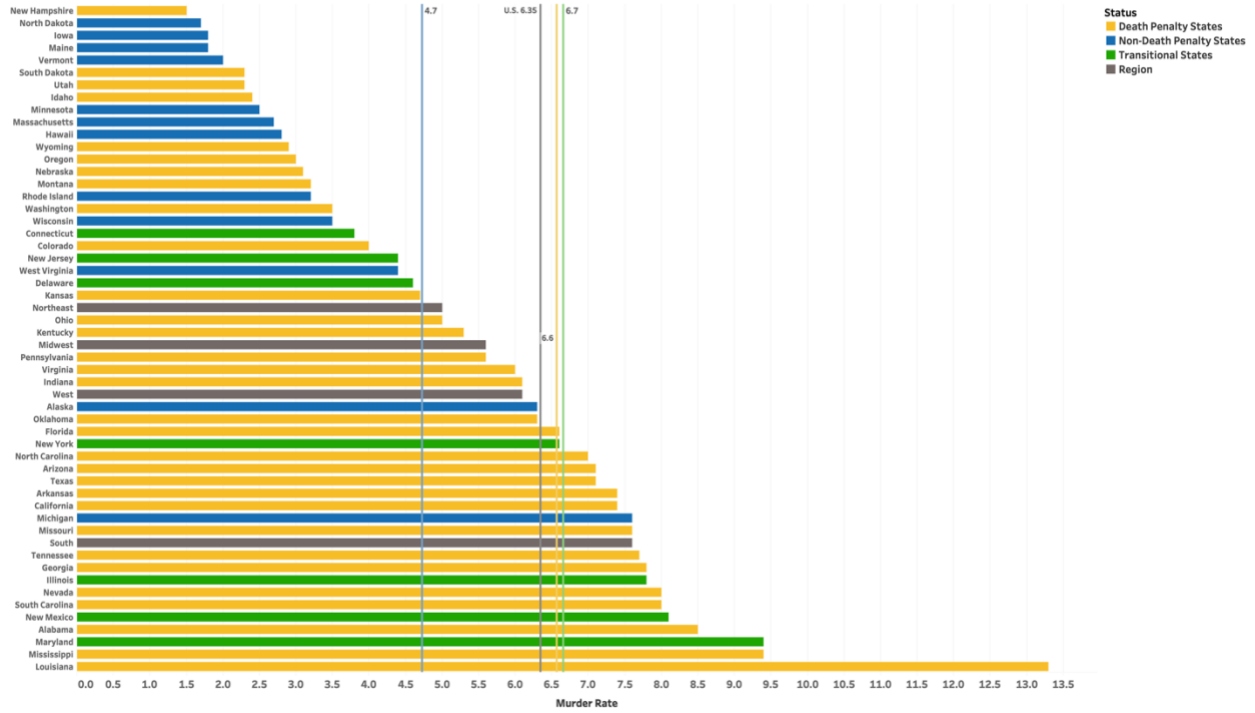
U.S. Murder Rate 1987-2017



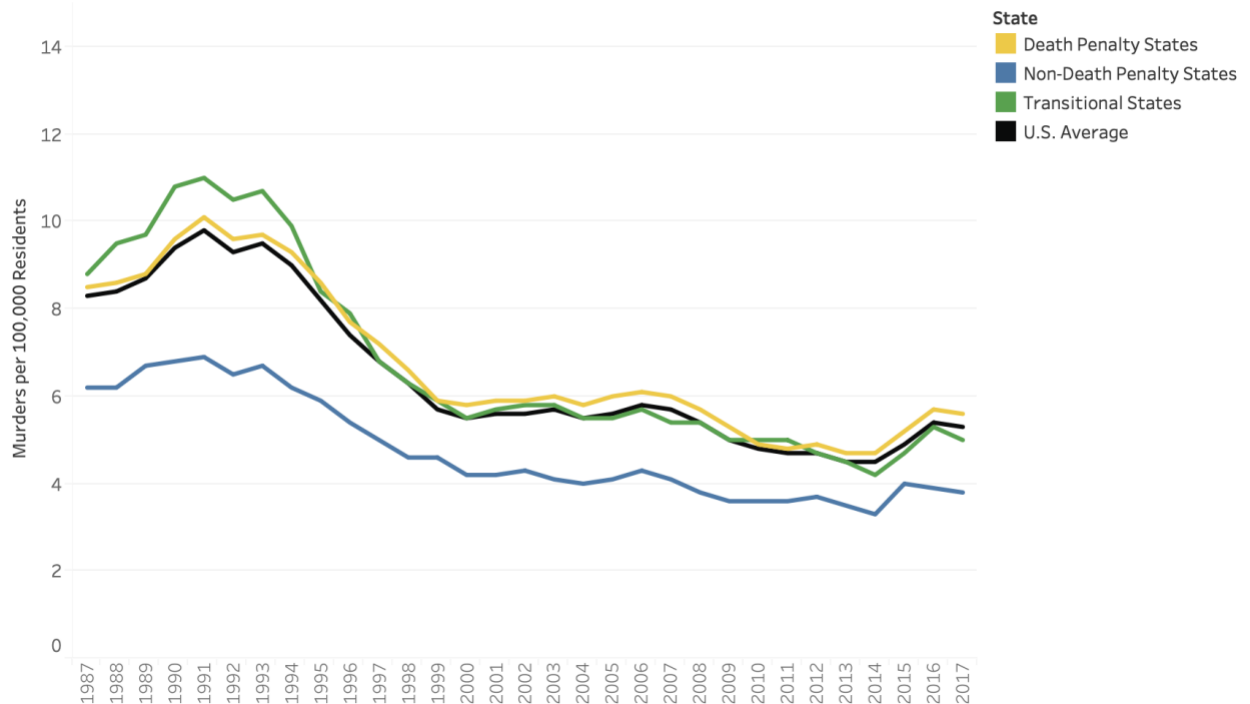
Murder Rate 1987-2017 (by Region)



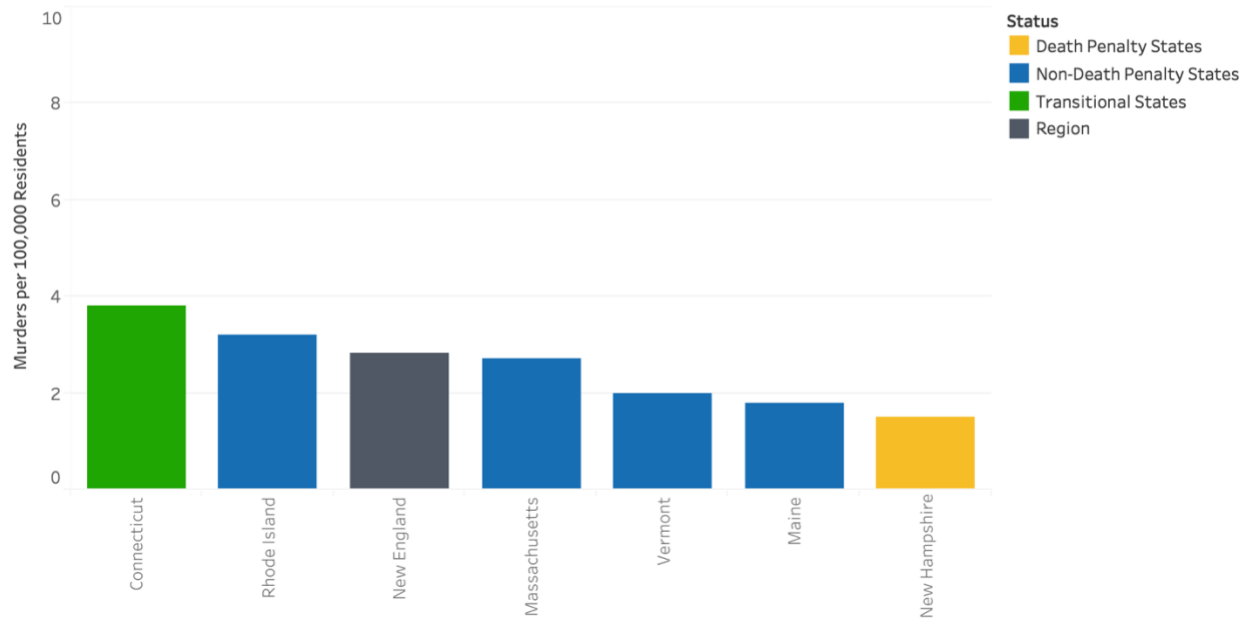
Murder Rate per 100,000 People 1987–2017



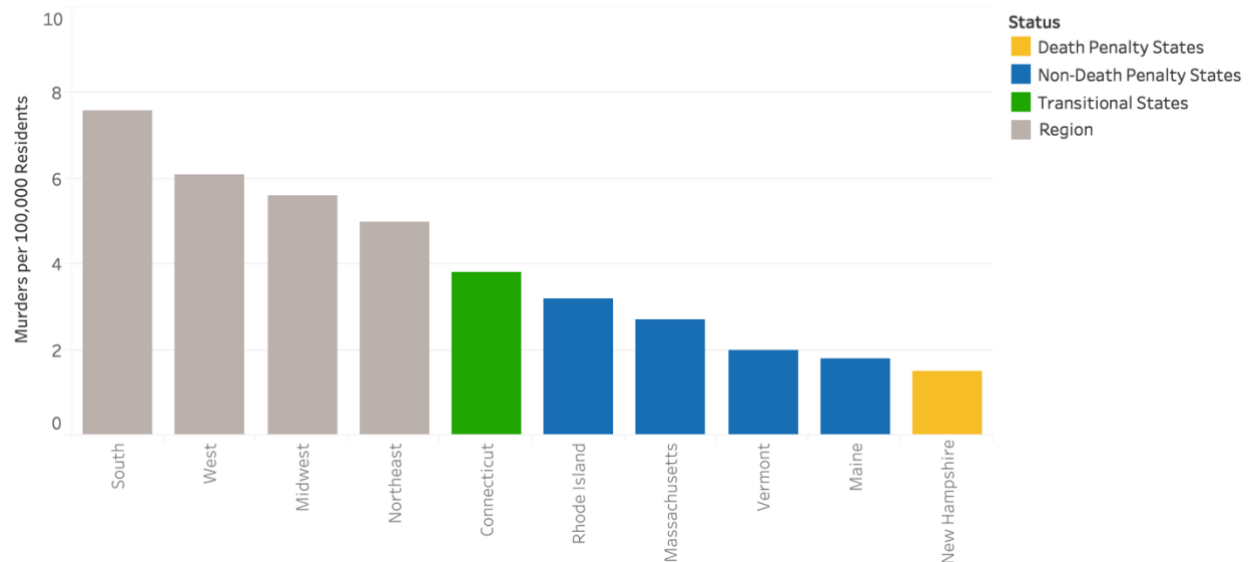

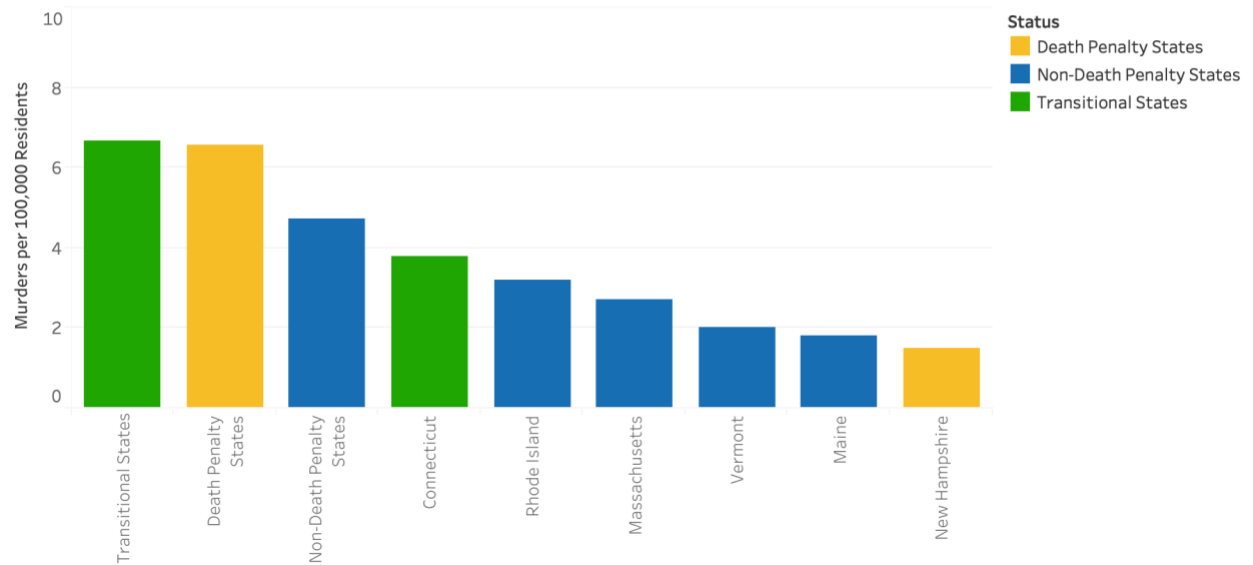
New England Murder Rates 1987-2017



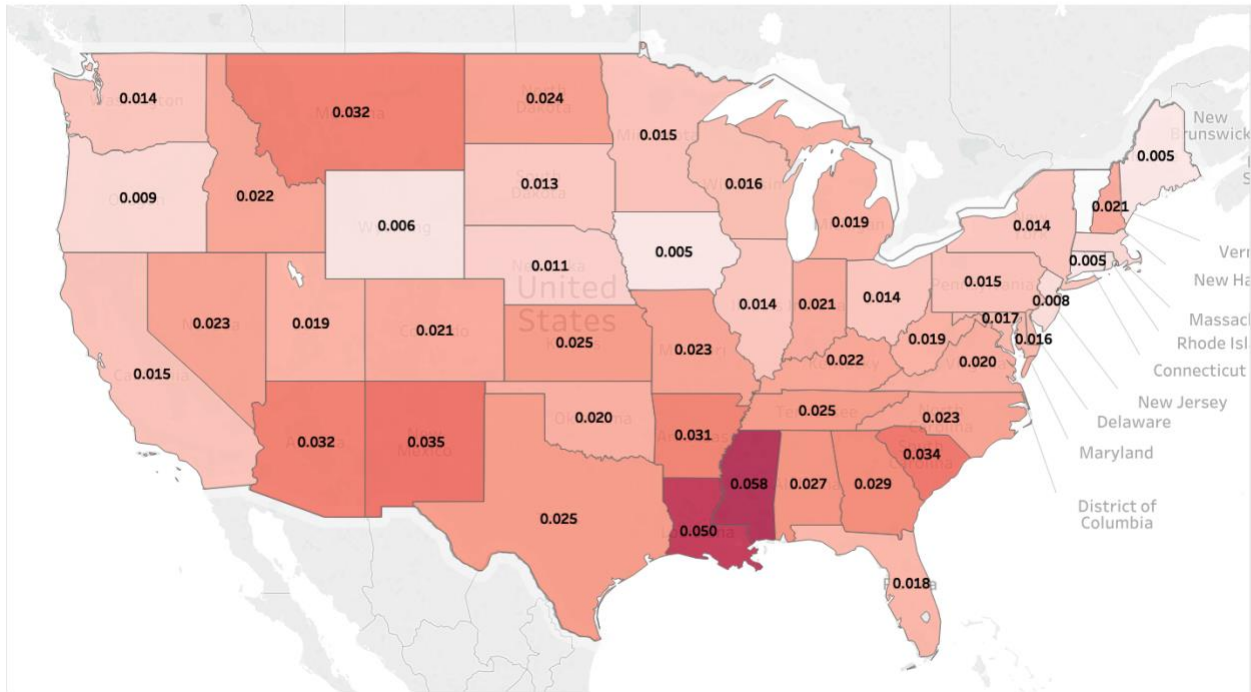
New England Murder Rates Compared to National Regions 1987-2017



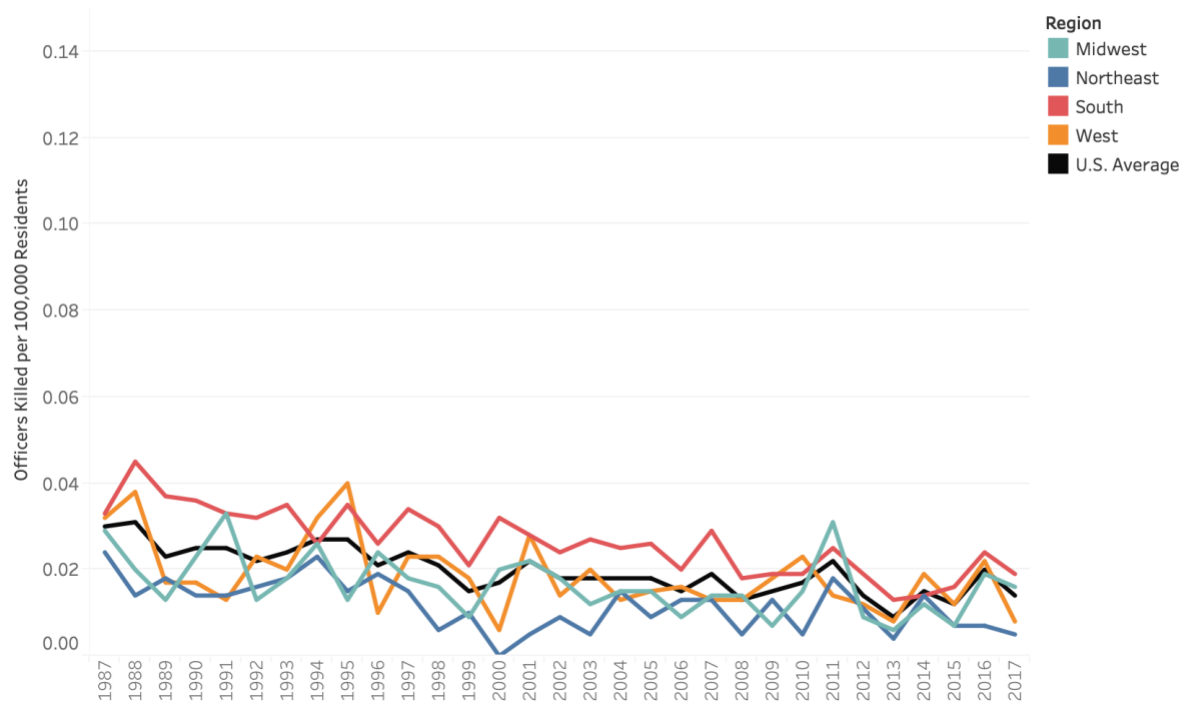
New England Murder Rates Compared to National Death Penalty Status 1987-2017



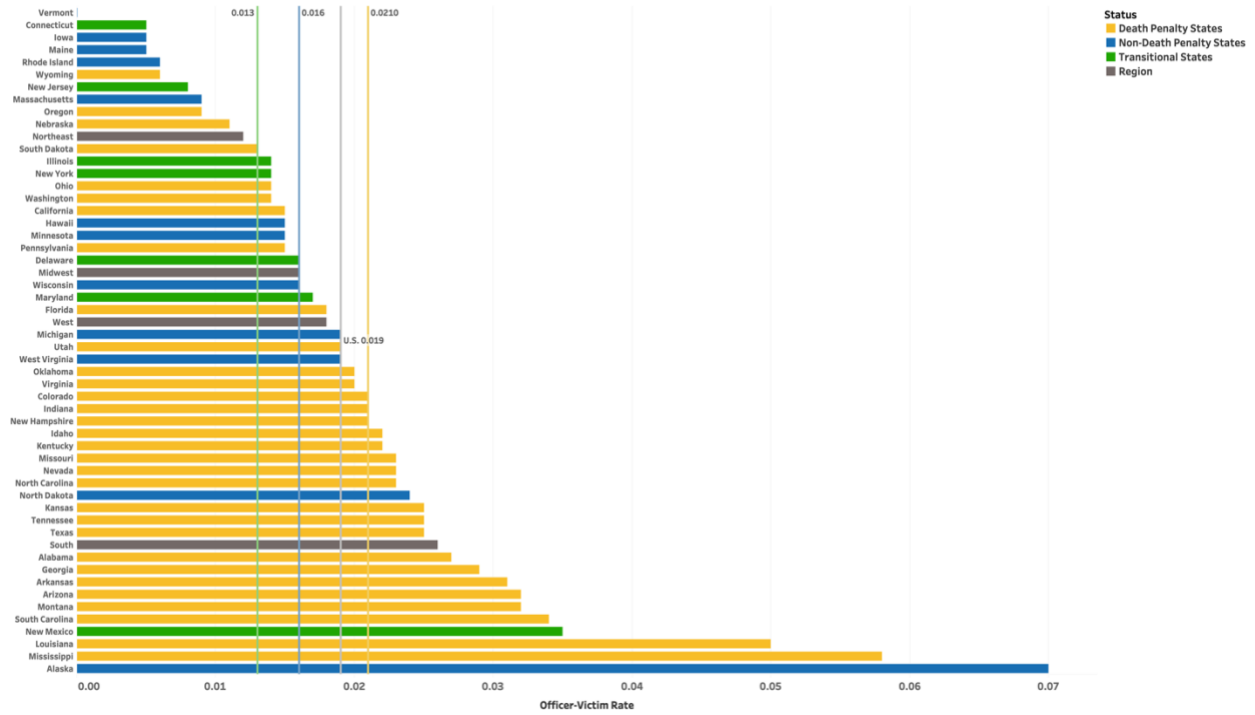
Officer-Victim Rate 1987-2017



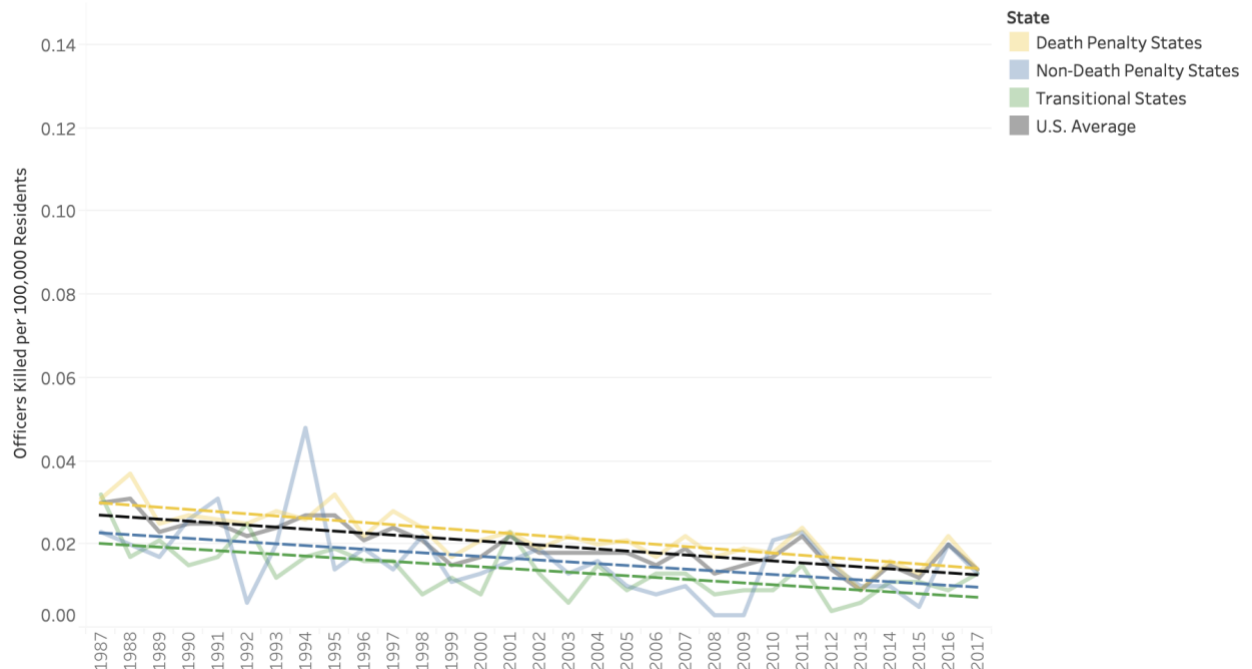
Officer Victim Rate 1987-2017 (by Region)



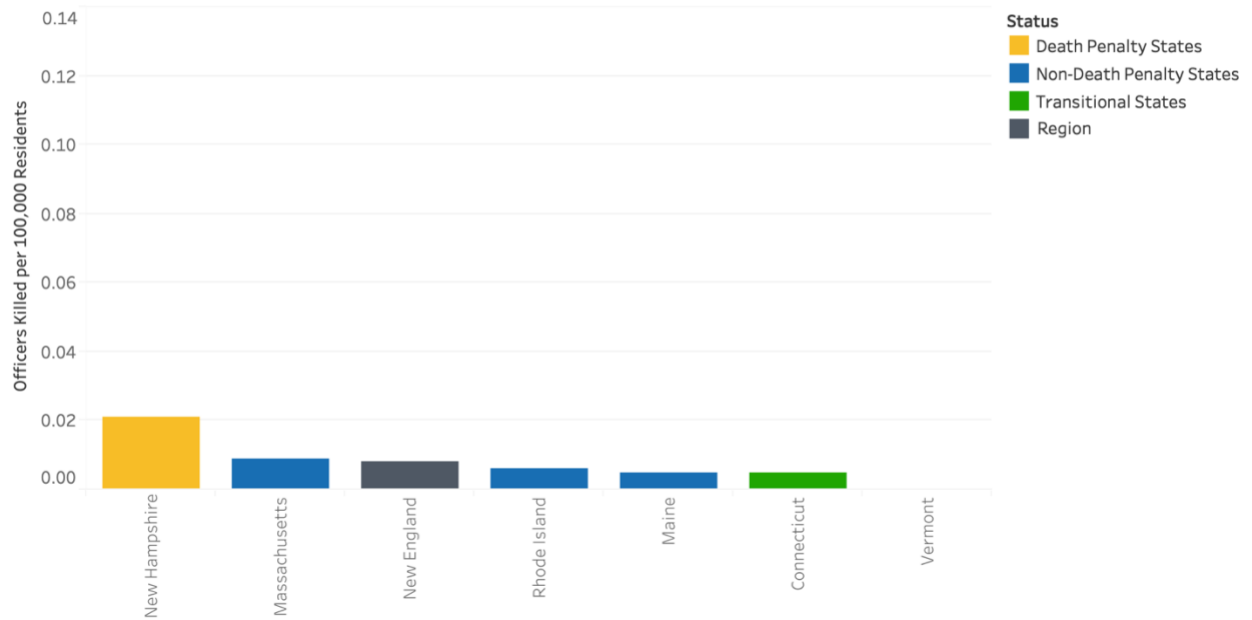
Officer Victim Rate per 100,000 People 1987–2017



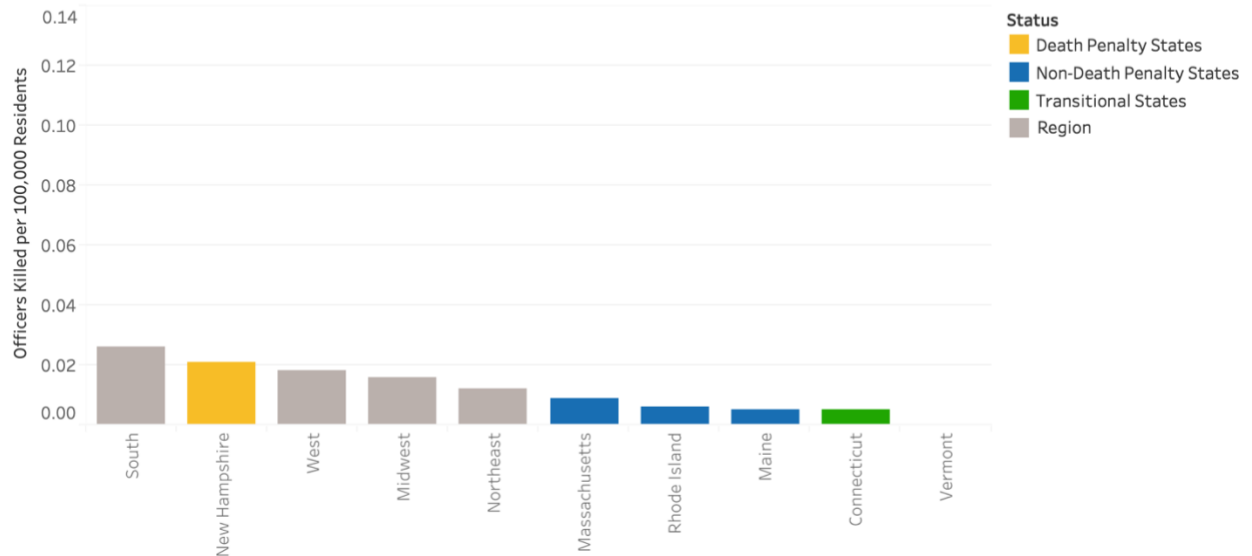

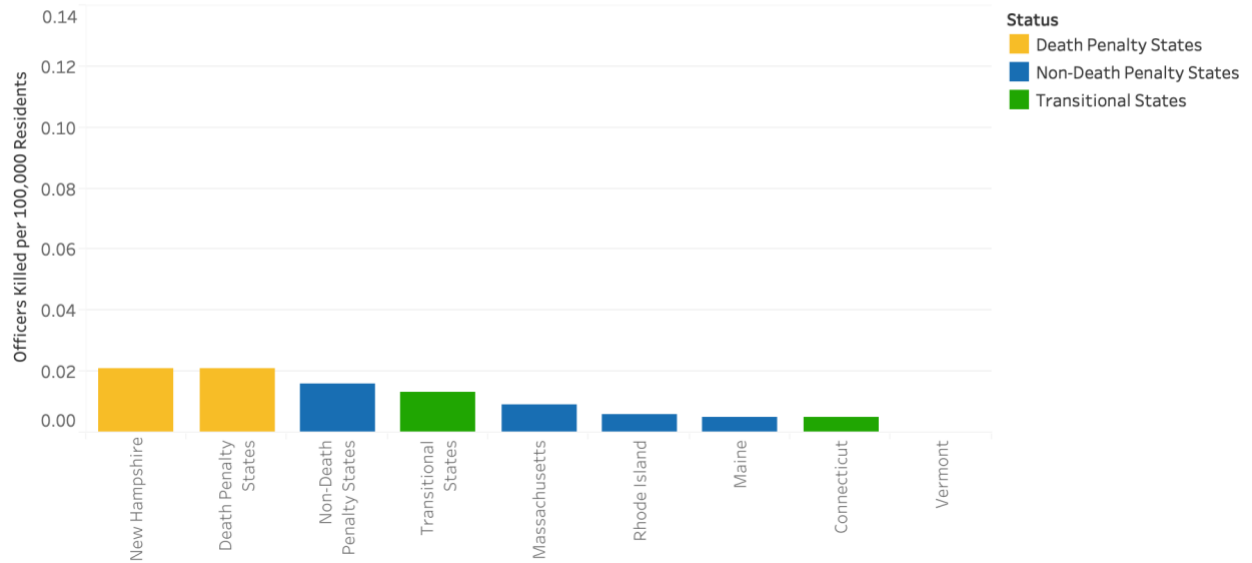
New England Officer-Victim Rates 1987-2017



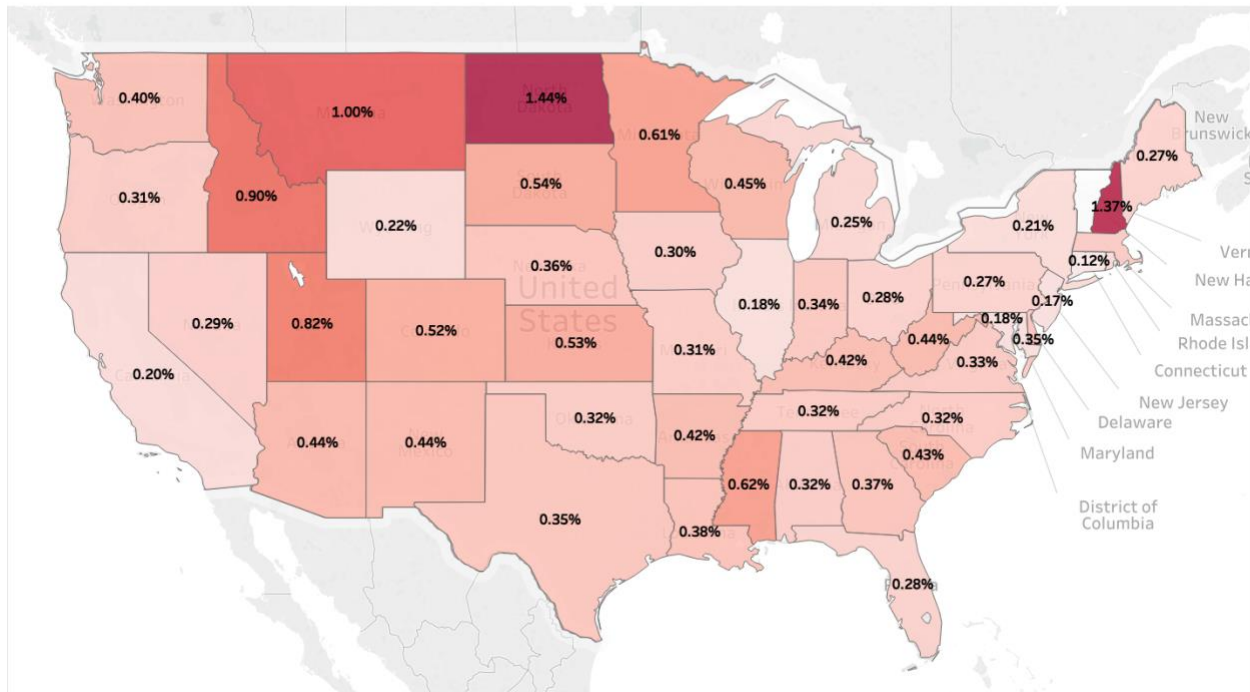
New England Officer-Victim Rates Compared to National Regions 1987-2017



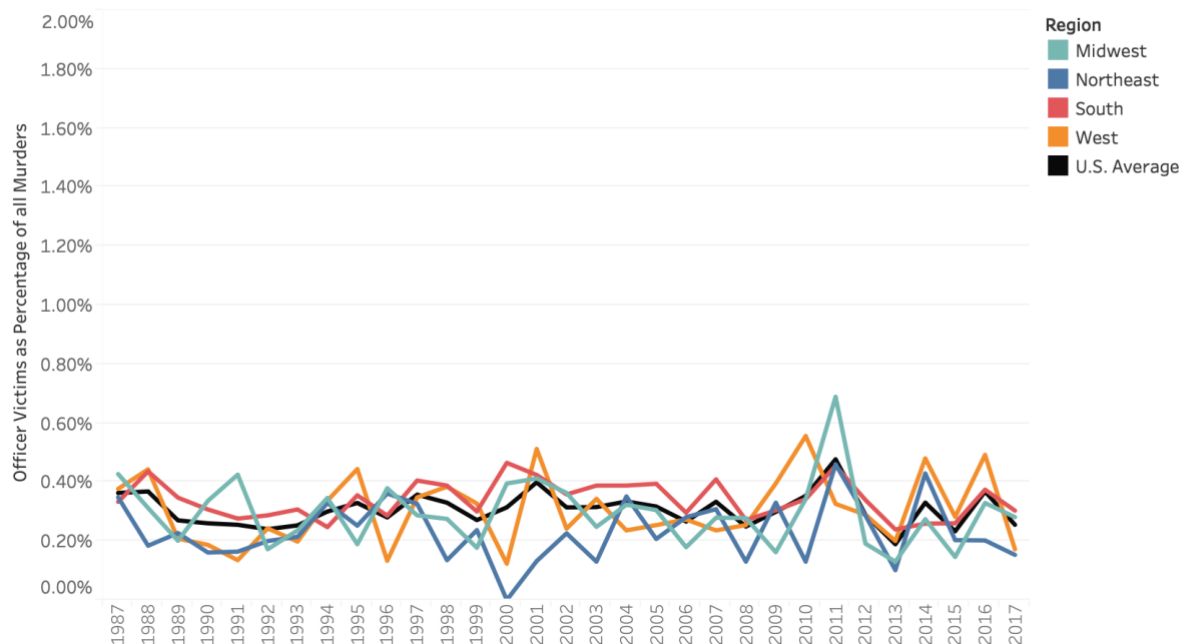
New England Officer-Victim Rates Compared to National Death Penalty Status 1987-2017



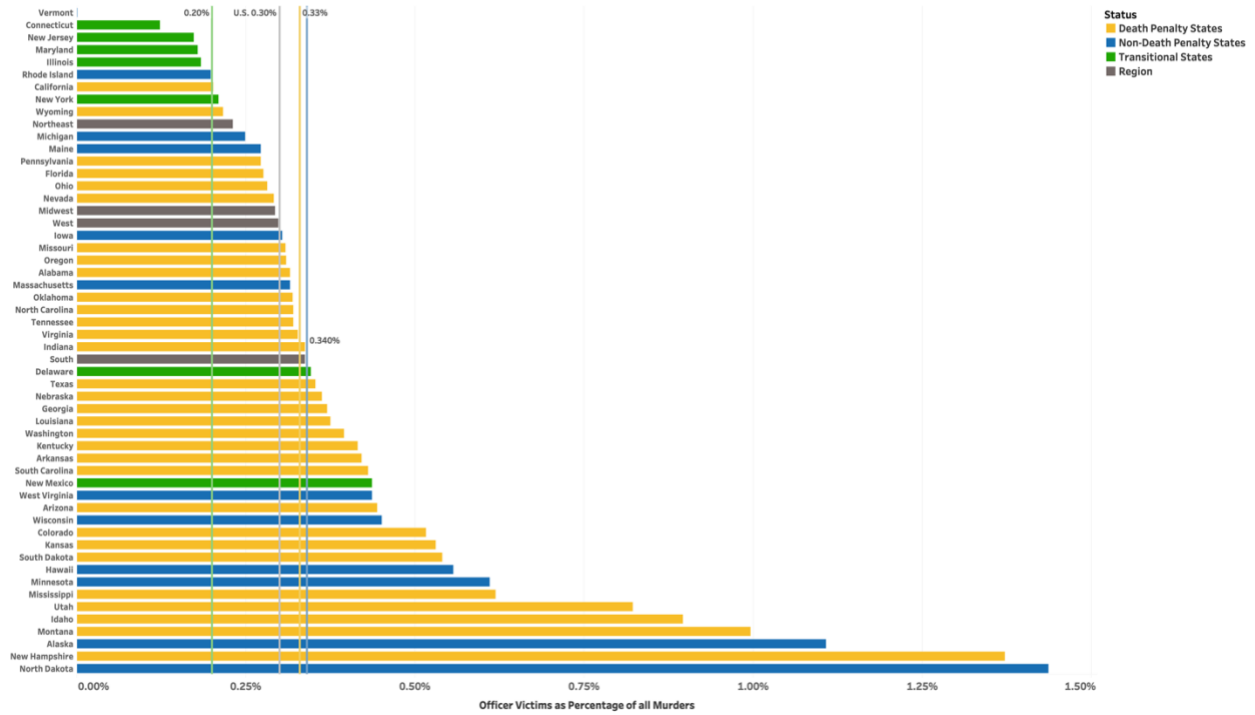
Officer Victims as Percentage of all Murders 1987–2017



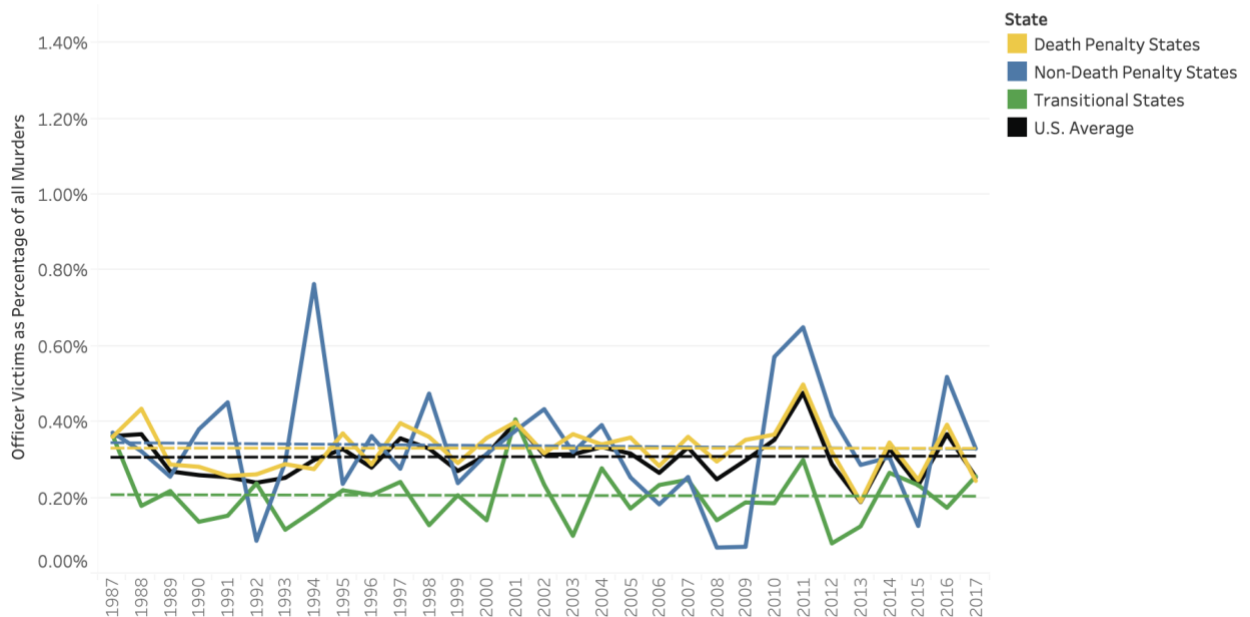
Officer Victims as a Percentage of all Murders 1987–2017 (by Region)



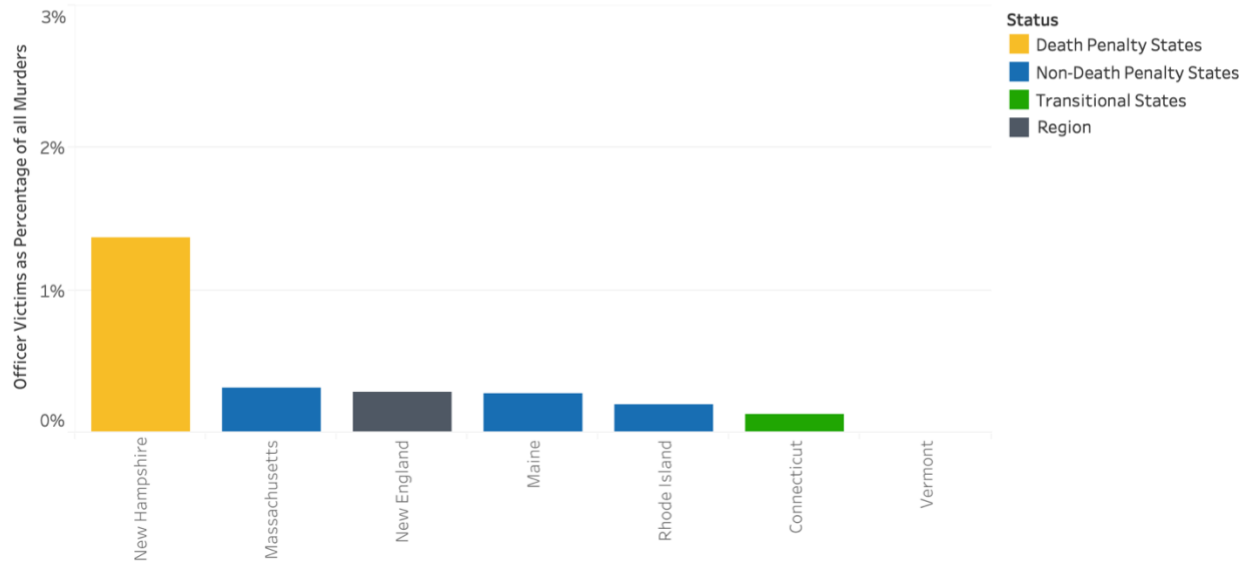

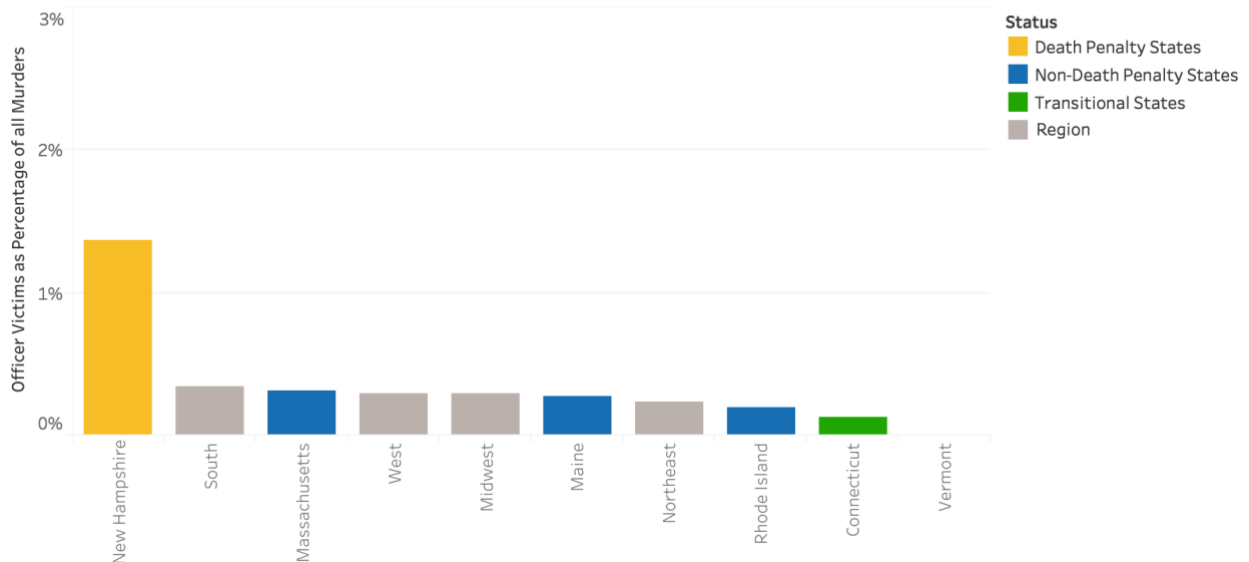
